could there be a berkeleian metaphysics without god did hume believe in causal powers what is kant's transcendental idealism each of the thirteen debates consists of a well known article or book chapter from a living philosopher followed by a new response from a different scholar specially commissioned for this volume every debate is prefaced by an introduction written for those coming upon the debates for the first time and followed by an annotated list for further reading the volume starts with an introduction that explains the importance and relevance of the modern period and its key debates to philosophy and ends with a glossary that covers terms from both the modern period and the study of the history of philosophy in general debates in modern philosophy will help students evaluate different interpretations of key texts from modern philosophy and provide a model for constructing their own positions in these debates

this is a topically organized introduction to the traditional problems of philosophy it aims to introduce readers to traditional philosophical problems and to expose readers to philosophical argumentation in such a way that they will feel confident in handling abstract concepts

reading curriculum theory the development of a new hermeneutic is a study of curriculum theory texts of the 1980s focusing on three divisions within the theoretical traditions of the field the conservative the reconceptualist and the reproductionist the book provides a hermeneutic reading of specific texts within each tradition the book relies heavily upon the interpretation theory of paul ricoeur and discusses ricoeur s theoretical works the book reveals and demonstrates that the ultimate aim of interpretive reading or the hermeneutic process is enhanced self understanding
